Board Bylaws

Conflict of Interest

- 1. No member of the Stafford Board of Education (the "Board") shall be employed for compensation by the Board in any position in the school system.
- 2. If any member of the Board is employed contrary to the provisions of this bylaw, the office to which the Board member was elected or appointed shall become vacant.
- 3. No member of the Stafford Board of Education shall provide a letter of recommendation for a person seeking a position within the Stafford Public School District.
