## Staff Spotlight








#### Model of the Month: Double Number Line

A special number line offers students a way to visualize fractional increments on this familiar yet powerful model. Just as the open number line allows students to visualize the relationships among multipliers, the special number line for fractions invites them to explore the relationships among different fractions. As they divide the number line into fractional increments, they find out where the positions of various fractions "line up."
