

## District Performance for 2015- 2016 Highlighted in CSDE Accountability Report

In 2015, the Connecticut Department of Education (CSDE) rolled out a new accountability system for schools and districts. It is called the Next Generation Accountability System. This system replaced the former District Performance Index and School Performance Index. Recently, the CSDE released the results for the 2015- 2016 school year- year two of the new system.

There are currently 20 reporting indicators, up from 16 indicators in 2014- 2015. Indicator 2: Growth (4 indicators) was added for 2015- 2016. At this time, no new indicators are anticipated for future years. Only at the district level do all 20 indicators apply. Each school has a varied number of indicators. The indicators are as follows:
