

Bylaws of the Board

Filling Vacancies

Whenever a vacancy on the Board shall occur, the Board shall fill the vacancy by the appointment of a competent and qualified person for the unexpired portion of the term. That person shall be of the same party affiliation as the person being replaced. The appropriate Town Committee shall be asked to recommend at least two candidates. The candidates will be interviewed by the Board, and, the Board will make the final decision. Such successor shall hold office until the next biennial election when the vacancy shall be filled in accordance with law.
